The U.S. Sanitary Commission, an organization staffed by thousands of women volunteers and a precursor to the Red Cross, was instrumental in relieving some of the suffering and hardships that soldiers faced. Cot-sized quilts were particularly in demand to combat the shortage of suitable bedding and the quicker they could be made the better. Of more than 250,000 quilts that were made for and distributed to Union soldiers, only a few exist today. This easy-to-piece quilt was inspired by one that's displayed at the Lincoln Memorial Shrine in Redlands, California, and is also similar to one used by the Home of the Brave Quilt Project in their efforts to distribute Civil War reproduction quilts to honor present-day soldiers and their families." 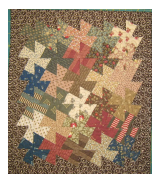
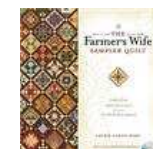
